Dear Residents, Family & Staff:

Starting Monday March 15, 2021, we will be taking steps to comply with the CMS and KY State guidance regarding visitation in LTC facilities. Although, some people may misinterpret this news as a return to normal, the same safeguards that have been in place for months will continue to be in place and practiced at our facility. We will continue to do screenings, temperature checks, facial coverings, social distancing and so on. Since our last positive test occurred on Tuesday March 2, 2021, our facility will begin visitation on Tuesday March 16, 2021 to comply with quarantine guidelines.

We will proceed with our plan for limited outdoor visits under the patio tent. We will expand and have additional opportunities for limited indoor visitation. Under special circumstances and following recommended guidelines, there may be the opportunity to visit in rooms for patients who have private rooms and those who meet criteria for compassionate care visits.

Compassionate care visits include end of life, those experiencing adjustment problems, or if the residents condition warrants the need to have contact with a family member. These visits will continue to be on a case- by- case basis. For more information, please consult with the Administrator or Director of Nursing.

Please observe for signage, which provides details for visitation guidelines, observing for signs & symptoms of infection and other pertinent information, as you enter the facility.
